Dear Sir:

Please be informed that it is no longer necessary to complete the certifications to the oath of allegiance which appear on the reverse surface of the various naturalization forms which are filed in your court, with two exceptions hereinafter indicated.

Section 337(a) of the Immigration and Nationality Act expressly provides that each petitioner for naturalization shall take the prescribed statutory oath of renunciation and allegiance in open court. 8 CFR 337.1 requires each such person to affix his signature to the oath as it appears on the petition or application for naturalization. The reverse surface of the original of Forms N-405 and N-407, the duplicate and triplicate copies of Form N-405A, and the original, duplicate and triplicate copies of Form N-408, all reflect the oath with a place for such signature and, immediately below, a place for a certification by the clerk of court. Presently such certifications are being completed by you.

The petitions and applications on the above described forms are all disposed of by court orders signed by the presiding judge. Such orders become a part of the permanent court records and, without exception, they recite that the petitioner or applicant has taken the required oath. Thus, a certification to the same effect by the clerk of court is surplusage. Furthermore, with two exceptions, neither the Act nor any regulation requires such certification. Accordingly, subject to the exceptions hereinafter indicated, you will no longer need to execute the certifications to the oath which appear on the reverse surface of the designated forms.


1. By specific language in Section 327 of the Act, certified copies of the oath must be sent to the Departments of Justice and State. 8 CFR 327.1 provides that the duplicate and triplicate copies

of Form N-405A, bearing a copy of the oath duly attested and certified by the clerk of court, shall be sent to the District Director for appropriate distribution. Thus, you will be required to continue the completion of these certifications.

2. Section 324 of the Act authorized the repatriated citizen to receive upon demand a certified copy of the proceedings inclusive of the oath administered. Under such circumstances, you will continue to complete the certification to the oath which appears on the reverse of the triplicate copy of Form N-408.

It should be understood that notwithstanding a discontinuance of the clerk's certification, the petitioner or applicant, as the case may be, will continue to be required to affix his signature to the oath in accordance with present practice.
