- Application for Appointment of Guardian of Alleged Incompetent (Ohio Supreme Court Form 17.0)
- Waiver of Notice and Consent (Ohio Supreme Court Form 15.1)
- Statement of Expert Evaluation (Ohio Supreme Court Form 17.1)
- Fiduciary's Acceptance – Guardian (Ohio Supreme Court Form 15.2)
- Information Concerning the Alleged Incompetent (Ashtabula County Probate Forms)

Additional Filings

- Certificate of Completed Guardian's Training (Received from Ohio Supreme Court, Reported with Form 27.2)
- Guardian's Inventory (For Guardians of Estate, Ohio Supreme Court Form 15.5)

Annual Filings

- Guardian's Report (Ohio Supreme Court Form 17.7)
- Statement of Expert Evaluation (Ohio Supreme Court Form 17.1)
- Annual Plan (Ohio Supreme Court Form 27.7, 27.8)
- Guardian's Account (Guardians of Estate, Ohio Supreme Court Form 15.8)
- 3-Hour Continuing Education Certificate (Received from Ohio Supreme Court, Reported with Form 27.2)

PLEASE NOTE: All guardian applicants must submit for a BCI background check. Guardianship hearings will not be set until the report is received by the Probate Court.
